Job Title: Chaplain

Type of Employment: Seasonal (as needed)

Position Purpose:

Serve as a spiritual leader to campers and staff. Assist campers in planning nightly worship services. Serve as a resource for campers who are working on social-emotional regulation.

Essential Job Functions:

The chaplain's job functions include but are not limited to:

- Assisting groups of campers in the preparation of nightly Vespers services.
- Be a resource for staff members as they prepare for their short morning worship services.
- Lead a minimum of one staff devotional a week.
- Assist campers who are experiencing difficulties with social-emotional regulation. Serve as a resource to assist with conflict resolution between campers.
- Assist directors as needed with leading all-camp services.

Other Job Duties:

The chaplain will also participate in camp life (i.e., all-camp activities, all-camp services, serving meals, weekly shifts on dishes, etc.) as able.

Relationships:

The chaplain will report directly to the Camp Director. They will have the opportunity to meet with every camper and help them to go further in their own questioning and spiritual development.

About Camp Wilmot:

Camp Wilmot is a Christian camp that provides camping experiences for adults and children of all ages. It is beautifully positioned on roughly 200 acres in New Hampshire, about 40 miles northwest of Concord. Our property features its own spring fed pond, large open fields and wooded areas, all ready to be explored. Woven throughout our daily activities is a Bible rooted curriculum selected annually to nurture the faith of all campers. Through daily bible study, praise music and nightly vespers services, our programs allow campers to experience faith in an entirely new way – in the great outdoors. All of our summer camps feature the fantastic outdoor activities that our grounds offer. Although Christianity is the foundation of what we do here at Camp Wilmot, we welcome with open arms anyone who is searching, or just beginning their own journey through spirituality, no matter what age or background.
