Job Title: Head Cook

Type of Employment: Seasonal (as needed)

Position Purpose:

To plan, direct and supervise the food service. Additionally they will prepare and serve food and clean kitchen facilities.

Essential Job Functions:

The cook's job functions include but are not limited to:

- Plan, purchase, prepare, and serve healthy and kid-friendly food for our campers three meals a day during the weeks specified below.
- Prepare meals for campers with special nutritional needs such as diabetic or gluten free diets.
- Manage one or two support staff, direct the same in proper food handling and cleaning procedures.
- Assure compliance with all applicable federal and state food service regulations.
- Ensure that the food is stored properly.
- Operate within budgetary concerns.

Other Job Duties:

The cook is also expected to carry out any special requests for food as agreed with the program directors. They will also plan menus in advance and utilize leftovers as necessary. Finally they will ensure that all kitchen rules are enforced and facilities are cleaned and well looked after.

Relationships:

The cook will report directly to the Camp Director. They will also oversee and supervise the cook's assistants, summer dishwasher and summer staff helpers (if applicable).

Equipment Used:

General kitchen equipment will be used (i.e. ovens, mixers, knives etc).

About the Kitchen: The Camp Wilmot kitchen is a full size industrial kitchen. Eight burner gas stove with flat top grill and two ovens, convection oven, walk-in refrigerator, ample preparation room, microwave ovens, industrial mixers, wide variety of baking and cooking pans, pots, trays, skillets, etc.

About Camp Wilmot:

Camp Wilmot is a Christian camp that provides camping experiences for adults and children of all ages. It is beautifully positioned on roughly 200 acres in New Hampshire, about 40 miles northwest of Concord. Our property features its own spring fed pond, large open fields and wooded areas, all ready to be explored. Woven throughout our daily activities is a Bible rooted curriculum selected annually to nurture the faith of all campers. Through daily bible study, praise music and nightly vespers services, our programs allow campers to experience faith in an entirely new way – in the great outdoors. All of our summer camps feature the fantastic outdoor activities that our grounds offer. Although Christianity is the foundation of what we do here at Camp Wilmot, we welcome with open arms anyone who is searching, or just beginning their own journey through spirituality, no matter what age or background.

Qualifications:

- ServSafe Certification
- Experience of cooking for large groups
- Ability to plan and prepare food to meet the needs of different dietary requirements.
- Knowledge of food preparation, serving, kitchen standards/ procedures.
- Ability to relate well to others
- Must be able and willing to work in a Christian camp environment
- Must be able to manage and supervise the transfer of heavy foodstuff.
- Must have knowledge of and ability to use kitchen equipment safely.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

The cook should be able to wash large dishes that cannot fit in the dishwasher.

Other:

- Private, on-site sleeping quarters.
- Must agree to CORI check.
