Job Title: Lifeguard

Type of Employment: Temporary as needed

Position Purpose:

To oversee and maintain a safe waterfront environment.

Essential Job Functions:

The lifeguard is expected to oversee the waterfront and to ensure that it is safe for all campers. The lifeguard will have all the campers complete a swim test at the beginning of camp. They will also be present for all waterfront activities. No one (staff included) is allowed at the waterfront without the supervision of the lifeguard.

Other Job Duties:

The lifeguard will ensure that everyone is following all waterfront rules. The lifeguard is expected to have read and understood the waterfront manual and to enforce all rules. The lifeguard is also expected to provide a safety demonstration to all staff during training in case of an emergency. The lifeguard may also be expected to fill the roles of a counselor.

Relationships:

The lifeguard will work with all the campers age ranging from 7 to 17. They will ensure that they are safe at all times during the swim time and require regular buddy checks.

Equipment Used:

The lifeguard is expected to be able to use the boating equipment well. They are to demonstrate to the camp director recues in the both the kayaks and canoes.

Qualifications:

Lifeguards must be currently certified. They must provide their certification upon employment.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Must demonstrate that they are strong confident swimmers.
